



Two-Factor Authentication

What is two-factor authentication?


Also known as **2FA**, two-factor authentication is basically an added layer of security. It means that as well as the standard login information, you will also be sent a code to input to verify who you are and access your Hive. It protects against the risk of a hacker finding out your login credentials, since they would also need your phone to get in.




How do you enable twofactor authentication?

It couldn't be easier. Just follow these steps:


- 1 Click on your User icon (your initials) in the bottom-left corner of the screen
- 2 Navigate to the 'Edit Profile' section




3 Enter your mobile phone number and hit save



4 Flip the 'Two-Factor Authentication' switch




5 We'll send you the six-digit code via SMS to your mobile number to validate your device



6 Enter your six-digit code to finish the validation

7 Click 'Save Changes'



And you're all done!



How does two-factor authentication work?


Once you've turned on two-factor authentication, logging in will have an extra step:

1 Visit the Hive login page, enter your email address and password, and click 'Sign in to your account'




You'll then receive a text from Hive with your


six-digit login code



3 Enter your six-digit code



4 Hive will then authenticate your credentials, which should only take a few moments



5 You'll then see a green tick and be taken straight through to your dashboard
